The **second** part consists of a conversation with your teacher, lasting about 2 minutes, based on the stimulus text provided. Use this information to answer the five questions your teacher will ask.

The **third** part takes the form of an open conversation with your teacher, lasting about 2 minutes, on one or more of the topics listed in the specification. Your teacher will choose the topic(s) and will ask you some questions.

The whole of the examination is to be recorded.
